1 AN ACT concerning

A BILL ENTITLED

2 Task Force on Pharmacy Technicians

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force on Pharmacy Technicians to evaluate
- 4 and make recommendations regarding pharmacy technicians in the State;
- 5 specifying the areas of study for the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to
- 6 recommend certain policies and standards; providing for the membership and
- 7 staffing of the Task Force; requiring a final report by a certain date; and
- 8 generally relating to the Task Force on Pharmacy Technicians.
- 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND. That:
- 11 (a) There is a Task Force on Pharmacy Technicians.
- 12 (b) The Task Force shall:
- 13 (1) (i) evaluate the functions performed by pharmacy technicians; and
- 14 (ii) evaluate the extent to which pharmacy technicians, including
- 15 those employed in grocery stores and large chain stores:
- 16 1. actually dispense prescription or nonprescription medicine
- 17 to consumers; and
- 18 2. should dispense prescription or nonprescription medicine
- 19 to consumers;
- 20 (2) evaluate the education and training required for employment as a
- 21 pharmacy technician;
- 22 (3) evaluate the public's perception of pharmacy technicians;
- 23 (4) evaluate other states' policies and standards regarding pharmacy
- 24 technicians; and
- 25 make recommendations regarding policies and standards to apply to
- 26 pharmacy technicians in the State.

- 1 (c) The Task Force shall be composed of:
- 2 (1) four members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of 3 the House; and
- 4 (2) four members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President 5 of the Senate.
- 6 (d) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Delegates 7 shall jointly select the Chair of the Task Force from the appointed members.
- 8 (e) The Department of Legislative Services shall provide staff support to the 9 Task Force.
- 10 (f) The Task Force shall provide a final report on its findings and
- 11 recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State
- 12 Government Article, to the General Assembly by December 31, 1998.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 June 1, 1998.
