BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 21 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 22 13-204. Except as authorized under § 13-303 of this title, the Secretary may not 23 24 continue certification for any contractual employee if: 25 the Secretary determines that the services performed under the (1) 26 contract:

encompass permanent functions;

- 1 [(2)] (II) have no specific expiration date; and
- 2 [(3)] (III) regularly are performed on a basis that is at least equal to 50% 3 of the work responsibility of a full-time permanent employee; OR
- 4 (2) CONTINUATION OF CERTIFICATION WOULD RESULT IN THE
- 5 CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYEE REMAINING IN A CONTRACTUAL POSITION FOR A PERIOD
- 6 OF TIME EXCEEDING 3 YEARS.

- 8 To enable a contractual employee to participate in any required examination for
- 9 a budgeted position under this subtitle, the Secretary may certify the continuation of
- 10 the employee's contract for a maximum period of 1 year after the date on which the
- 11 budgeted position is created.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 1998.
