25 26	(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
27 28	(B) "EMPLOYEE" MEANS A FIRE, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, PARAMEDIC, OR RESCUE EMPLOYEE HIRED OR COMPENSATED BY AN EMPLOYER.

- 1 (C) "EMPLOYER" MEANS A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT OR ENTITY.
- 2 (D) "STATEWIDE REEMPLOYMENT LIST" MEANS THE LIST KEPT BY THE STATE
- 3 FIRE MARSHAL CONTAINING THE NAMES OF EMPLOYEES WHO ARE SEPARATED
- 4 FROM EMPLOYMENT.

- 6 (A) IF AN EMPLOYEE IS SEPARATED FROM EMPLOYMENT BECAUSE OF LACK
- 7 OF WORK, LACK OF FUNDING FOR THE POSITION, OR ABOLITION OF THE POSITION,
- 8 THE EMPLOYER SHALL FORWARD THE EMPLOYEE'S NAME TO THE STATE FIRE
- 9 MARSHAL, WHO SHALL PLACE THE EMPLOYEE'S NAME ON THE STATEWIDE
- 10 REEMPLOYMENT LIST.
- 11 (B) THE NAMES OF EMPLOYEES ON THE LIST SHALL BE SET FORTH IN THE
- 12 ORDER OF THEIR SENIORITY.
- 13 (C) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, AN
- 14 EMPLOYEE PLACED ON THE REEMPLOYMENT LIST SHALL REMAIN THERE FOR A
- 15 PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 5 YEARS FROM THE DATE OF THE SEPARATION FROM

- 17 (D) AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS REINSTATED BY A PREVIOUS EMPLOYER OR AS A
- 18 PERMANENT EMPLOYEE EMPLOYED BY A DIFFERENT EMPLOYER SHALL BE
- 19 REMOVED FROM THE REEMPLOYMENT LIST.

- 21 (A) THE STATEWIDE LIST SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL EMPLOYEES ON
- 22 THE STATEWIDE REEMPLOYMENT LIST.
- 23 (B) WHEN AN EMPLOYER BEGINS A HIRING PROCESS TO FILL NEW OR
- 24 VACANT POSITIONS, THE EMPLOYER SHALL FORWARD THAT INFORMATION TO THE
- 25 STATE FIRE MARSHAL FOR PLACEMENT ON THE LIST OF OPEN POSITIONS.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 1998.
