## Preamble

- 21 WHEREAS, Each health occupation board has a mandate to protect the health,
- 22 safety, and welfare of the citizens of the State by licensing, regulating, and
- 23 disciplining health care practitioners;

1 WHEREAS, The health occupations boards have made significant progress in 2 addressing this mandate since the General Assembly established the boards as 3 special funded agencies in 1993;

4 WHEREAS, The health occupations boards assign the highest priority to 5 addressing disciplinary matters related to complaints received against licensees;

6 WHEREAS, Each health occupation board has difficulty in predicting the 7 amount of funds necessary to meet certain costs related to disciplinary actions, 8 litigation, and certain legislative mandates;

9 WHEREAS, Current policy requires a health occupations board to submit a 10 proposed budget amendment in order to access its surplus funds each time the board 11 incurs an unanticipated expense related to a disciplinary action, litigation, and 12 certain legislative mandates;

WHEREAS, If the performance of each health occupation board is to
significantly improve a reform allowing each board to establish a project reserve fund,
to be expended on unanticipated expenses related to disciplinary actions, litigation,
and certain legislative mandates, must be implemented; and

WHEREAS, No health occupation board will increase fees for its services in
order to establish a project reserve fund or to allocate money to the project reserve
fund; now, therefore,
