1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Board of Environmental Sanitarians - Recent Licensees - Report to Local**
3 **Governments**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Environmental Sanitarians to keep
5 a certain current record of persons initially licensed within a certain period of
6 time; requiring the Board to provide the record, on request, to a local
7 governmental entity; and generally relating to reporting by the Board with
8 respect to recent licensees.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Environment**

17 11-311.

18 (a) The Board shall keep a current record of each application for licensure.

19 (b) The record shall include:

20 (1) The name, residence address, and age of each applicant;

21 (2) The name and address of the applicant's employer;

22 (3) The date of the application;

23 (4) Complete information on the education and experience qualifications
24 of each applicant;

25 (5) The date the Board reviewed and acted on the application;

- 1 (6) The action taken by the Board on the application;
- 2 (7) The serial number of any registration or license issued to the
3 applicant; and
- 4 (8) Any other information that the Board considers necessary.

5 (C) THE BOARD SHALL KEEP A CURRENT RECORD OF THE NAME AND
6 ADDRESS OF ENVIRONMENTAL SANITARIANS INITIALLY LICENSED BY THE BOARD IN
7 THE PREVIOUS 2 YEARS AND, ON REQUEST, PROVIDE THE RECORD TO A LOCAL
8 GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 1998.
