Creation of a State Debt - Washington County - Rohrersville Band

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$25,000,

- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Rohrersville Band for certain
- 5 acquisition, development, or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement
- 6 of the loan proceeds; requiring the grantee to grant and convey a certain
- 7 <u>easement to the Maryland Historical Trust</u>; and providing generally for the
- 8 issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Washington
County - Rohrersville Band Loan of 1998 in the total principal amount of \$25,000.
This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general
obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued,
sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance
and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

18 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 19 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under 20 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

21 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer

22 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and

23 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

24 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the

4 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 5 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 6 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 7 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
