- 26 license or a special Class C beer and wine license entitles the holder to exercise any of
- 27 the privileges conferred by the respective classes of licenses for the use of any person
- 28 holding any bona fide entertainment conducted by any club, society or association at
- 29 the place described in the license, for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days
- 30 from the effective date thereof.


