1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Deicing Chemicals - Annual Reports**

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain persons to prepare annual reports identifying
- 4 the handling, use, and storage of certain deicing chemicals; and generally
- 5 relating to deicing chemicals.
- 6 BY adding to

- 9 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 10 (1996 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Environment
- 14 4-421.
- 15 (A) EACH OWNER, OPERATOR, OR LICENSEE OF ANY SOURCE OF A DISCHARGE
- 16 OF PROPYLENE-GLYCOL OR OTHER RELATED DEICING CHEMICALS SHALL SUBMIT A
- 17 REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT RELATING TO THE USE, HANDLING, AND STORAGE OF
- 18 THESE CHEMICALS.
- 19 (B) THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL
- 20 CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 21 (1) THE TOTAL VOLUME OF DEICING CHEMICALS PURCHASED BY THE
- 22 OWNER, OPERATOR, OR LICENSEE DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR;
- 23 (2) THE TOTAL VOLUME OF DEICING CHEMICALS USED BY THE OWNER,
- 24 OPERATOR, OR LICENSEE DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR;
- 25 (3) THE TOTAL VOLUME OF DEICING CHEMICALS STORED BY THE
- 26 OWNER, OPERATOR, OR LICENSEE DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR;

- 1 (4) THE TOTAL VOLUME OF DEICING CHEMICALS RECEIVED BY THE 2 OWNER, OPERATOR, OR LICENSEE DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR; AND
- 3 (5) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE.
- 4 (C) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1999, EACH OWNER, OPERATOR, OR LICENSEE
- 5 SHALL ANNUALLY REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT THE INFORMATION REQUIRED
- 6 UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 7 (D) THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL 8 BE KEPT FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS.
- 9 (E) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION:
- 10 (1) IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANY OTHER PENALTY OR INJUNCTION IN THIS 11 SUBTITLE; AND
- 12 (2) IS SUBJECT TO A PENALTY IMPOSED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 14 October 1, 1998.
