13 (3) At the end of a term, a commissioner continues to serve until a 14 successor is appointed and takes the oath of office.

15 (4) A commissioner who is appointed after a term has begun serves only 16 for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and takes the oath of office.

17 (d) A vacancy on the WSSC does not impair the right of the remaining 18 commissioners to exercise all the powers of the WSSC.

19 (e) (1) Each appointee shall be a resident of the sanitary district.

(2) [An] EXCEPT FOR THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS OF
PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY AND MONTGOMERY COUNTY, THE CHAIRMAN OF THE
