- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Tax Property
- 14 7-218.1.
- 15 PROPERTY IS NOT SUBJECT TO PROPERTY TAX IF THE PROPERTY:
- 16 (1) IS OWNED BY THE WESTERN SHORE CONSERVANCY; AND
- 17 (2) IS USED:
- 18 (I) TO ASSIST IN THE PRESERVATION OF A WILD NATURE AREA;
- 19 (II) TO ESTABLISH A NATURE RESERVE OR OTHER PROTECTED
- 20 AREA; OR
- 21 (III) GENERALLY TO PROMOTE CONSERVATION.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 23 June 30, 1998, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after July 1,
- 24 1998.
