- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to waive certain skill
- 4 test requirements for an applicant for a certain commercial driver's license to
- 5 operate a school vehicle if the applicant holds a valid commercial driver's
- 6 license, has operated a commercial motor vehicle for a certain period, and has
- 7 never been disqualified from operating a commercial motor vehicle; and

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (b) (1) An individual may not be issued a commercial driver's license until
- 25 the individual has passed the knowledge and skill tests for driving a commercial
- 26 motor vehicle which complies with the minimum federal standards established by the
- 27 federal Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986 (Title XII of Public Law 99-570),

1 and has satisfied all other requirements of that act as well as any other requirements 2 of this title. (2) The tests shall be prescribed and conducted at the direction of the 4 Administration. The Administration shall adopt regulations to waive the skill test 6 required under paragraph (1) of this subsection in a manner consistent with 49 CFR 7 § 383.77. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IN THE CASE 8 9 OF AN APPLICANT FOR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE ENDORSED "PASSENGER 10 VEHICLE" THAT AUTHORIZES THE OPERATION OF A SCHOOL VEHICLE ON A 11 HIGHWAY IN THE STATE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL WAIVE THE SKILL TEST 12 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION IF THE APPLICANT: 13 (I) HOLDS A VALID COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE; 14 HAS OPERATED A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE FOR AT LEAST (II)15 2 YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF APPLICATION FOR THE 16 PASSENGER ENDORSED COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE; AND HAS NEVER BEEN DISQUALIFIED FROM DRIVING A 17 (III) 18 COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE UNDER § 16-812 OF THIS SUBTITLE OR SIMILAR 19 PROVISIONS OF ANOTHER STATE. 20 16-816. An individual may not drive a school vehicle (school bus) on any highway 21 (a) 22 in this State unless the individual: 23 (1) Passes an appropriate medical examination; and 24 (2) Has been issued a commercial driver's license endorsed passenger 25 vehicle. With the advice of the State Department of Education, the Administration 26 (b) 27 may adopt regulations concerning the qualifications of school vehicle drivers. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 29 October 1, 1998.
