20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF	

21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages** 2 2-208. 3 (a) There is a Class 7 micro-brewery (on- and off-sale) license. 4 (d) The on-sale privilege authorizes the holder, each calendar year, to 5 sell at retail up to 4,000 barrels of beer brewed under this license to customers for 6 consumption on the licensed premises. 7 The off-sale privilege authorizes the holder to sell and deliver beer 8 brewed under this license to: 9 (i) Any wholesaler licensed under this article to sell beer in this 10 State; or 11 (ii) Any person who is located in a state other than Maryland who is 12 authorized under the laws of that state to receive brewed beverages. 13 (3) (i) This paragraph applies only in: 14 1. The City of Annapolis; 2. 15 Anne Arundel County; 16 3. Baltimore City; 4. Baltimore County; 17 5. Calvert County; 18 19 6. Charles County; 20 7. Dorchester County; 21 8. Frederick County; 22 9. Harford County; 10. 23 Howard County; 24 11. MONTGOMERY COUNTY; 12. Prince George's County; and 25 26 [12] 13. Talbot County. 27 (ii) The holder may sell at retail beer brewed under this license to 28 customers for consumption off the licensed premises in refillable containers that are 29 sealed by the micro-brewery licensee at the time of each refill.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1998.
