1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcoholic Beverages - Town of Kensington - Special License**
3 **MC 805-98**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Montgomery County Board of License
5 Commissioners to issue a certain limited special on-sale beer, wine, and liquor
6 license to certain organizations holding certain events on municipal property in
7 the town of Kensington in Montgomery County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
10 Section 8-216(a)(2)
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (1996 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 8-216.

17 (a) (2) (i) Except as provided in [subparagraph (ii)] SUBPARAGRAPHS (II)
18 AND (III) of this paragraph, in Montgomery County, a license for the sale of alcoholic
19 beverages authorized by this article may not be issued for any place of business
20 located in Damascus (12th election district), and in the towns of Barnesville,
21 Kensington, Laytonsville, Washington Grove and the City of Takoma Park.

1 (ii) In the town of Barnesville, the Montgomery County Board of
2 License Commissioners may issue a special 7-day on-sale beer, wine, and liquor
3 license to any bona fide religious, fraternal, civic, or charitable organization.

4 (III) IN THE TOWN OF KENSINGTON, THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY
5 BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL 2-DAY ON-SALE BEER,
6 WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE TO ANY BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS, FRATERNAL, CIVIC, OR
7 CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION HOLDING AN EVENT ON MUNICIPAL PROPERTY.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 July 1, 1998.
