CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Medicaid - Emergency Service Transporters - Reimbursement

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to
- 4 reimburse certain public emergency service transporters for the costs of
- 5 transportation and medical services provided to a Medicaid Program recipient
- during transport to certain facilities if the emergency service transporter
- 7 charges for its services and requests reimbursement from the Program;
- 8 requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations on or before a certain
- 9 date negotiate the rate of reimbursement with certain public emergency service
- transporters for the costs of transportation and medical services provided to a
- 11 Medicaid Program recipient; defining a certain term; providing for a delayed
- effective date; and generally relating to reimbursement for certain emergency

HOUSE BILL 918

- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 3 Article Health General
- 4 1-101.
- 5 (a) In this article the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 6 (c) "Department" means the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.
- 7 15-101.
- 8 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 9 (c) "Facility" means a hospital or nursing facility including an intermediate
- 10 care facility, skilled nursing facility, comprehensive care facility, or extended care
- 11 facility.
- 12 (h) "Program" means the Maryland Medical Assistance Program.
- 13 (i) "Program recipient" means an individual who receives benefits under the
- 14 Program.
- 15 15-114.1.
- 16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "EMERGENCY SERVICE TRANSPORTER" MEANS A
- 17 PUBLIC ENTITY OR VOLUNTEER FIRE, RESCUE, OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE
- 18 THAT PROVIDES EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.
- 19 (B) IF AN EMERGENCY SERVICE TRANSPORTER CHARGES FOR ITS SERVICES
- 20 AND REQUESTS REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 21 REIMBURSE THE EMERGENCY SERVICE TRANSPORTER FOR THE COST OF:
- 22 (1) TRANSPORTATION THE EMERGENCY SERVICE TRANSPORTER
- 23 PROVIDES TO A PROGRAM RECIPIENT TO A FACILITY; AND
- 24 (2) MEDICAL SERVICES THE EMERGENCY SERVICE TRANSPORTER
- 25 PROVIDES TO THE PROGRAM RECIPIENT WHILE TRANSPORTING THE PROGRAM
- 26 RECIPIENT TO A FACILITY.
- 27 (C) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 1998, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT ANY
- 28 REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.
- 29 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NEGOTIATE THE RATE OF REIMBURSEMENT
- 30 WITH AN EMERGENCY SERVICE TRANSPORTER IF THE EMERGENCY SERVICE
- 31 TRANSPORTER CHARGES FOR ITS SERVICES AND REQUESTS REIMBURSEMENT FROM
- 32 THE PROGRAM FOR THE SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS
- 33 SECTION.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998 July 1, 1999.
