- 3 FOR the purpose of expanding the scope of certain provisions that authorize the
- 4 Motor Vehicle Administration to adopt a system of staggered vehicle registration
- 5 for certain classes of motor vehicles to make these provisions applicable to all
- 6 classes of vehicles; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to
- 7 the registration of motor vehicles.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article - Transportation

- 22 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE
- 23 ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT A SYSTEM OF STAGGERED REGISTRATION FOR ANY
- 24 MOTOR VEHICLE CLASS.
- 25 (B) (1) DURING THE REGISTRATION PERIOD IN WHICH THE SYSTEM IS
- 26 INITIATED, VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS MAY BE ISSUED FOR PERIODS VARYING FROM 7
- 27 MONTHS TO 18 MONTHS WITH FEES PRORATED ACCORDING TO THE NUMBER OF
- 28 MONTHS FOR WHICH THE REGISTRATION IS ISSUED.

- 1 (2) VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATES OR VALIDATION TABS SHALL BE 2 ISSUED AND DISPLAYED IN ACCORDANCE WITH A SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED BY THE
- 3 ADMINISTRATION.
- 4 (3) ANY NEW REGISTRATION OR RENEWAL ISSUED DURING THE YEAR
- 5 MAY BE ISSUED INITIALLY FOR OTHER THAN A 12-MONTH PERIOD TO FACILITATE AN
- 6 EQUAL VOLUME OF MONTHLY ISSUANCES AND THE REGISTRATION FEE SHALL BE
- 7 PRORATED FOR THE PERIOD ISSUED.
- 8 (4) FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING RELATIVELY UNIFORM WORK
- 9 LOADS, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL EVALUATE MONTHLY VOLUMES OF
- 10 REGISTRATION RENEWALS FROM TIME TO TIME AND ANY PORTION OF A MONTHLY
- 11 ISSUANCE MAY BE RESCHEDULED BY APPLYING A DIFFERENT EXPIRATION DATE
- 12 AND PRORATING THE FEE ACCORDINGLY.
- 13 (5) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL REFUND A REGISTRATION FEE ON
- 14 SURRENDER OF A REGISTRATION CARD AND UNUSED REGISTRATION PLATES BY THE
- 15 OWNER AS PROVIDED UNDER § 13-938 OF THIS SUBTITLE ONLY IF THE RETURN IS
- 16 MADE PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE REGISTRATION PERIOD FOR WHICH
- 17 THE APPLICATION FOR REFUND IS MADE.
- 18 (6) WHEN THE ADMINISTRATION ASSESSES A PRORATED FEE, IT SHALL
- 19 BE CALCULATED BY MULTIPLYING ONE-TWELFTH OF THE APPLICABLE FEE BY THE
- 20 NUMBER OF MONTHS FOR WHICH THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL IS MADE AND
- 21 ADJUSTING THIS AMOUNT TO THE NEAREST DOLLAR AMOUNT.
- 22 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT AND
- 23 OPERATE A STAGGERED REGISTRATION SYSTEM AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS
- 24 SECTION.

- 26 (a) When registered with the Administration, every passenger car and station
- 27 wagon, except as otherwise provided in this part, is a Class A (passenger) vehicle.
- 28 (b) For each Class A (passenger) vehicle, the annual registration fee is:
- 29 (1) For a vehicle with a manufacturer's shipping weight of 3,700 pounds
- 30 or less -- \$27.00; and
- 31 (2) For a vehicle with a manufacturer's shipping weight of more than
- 32 3,700 pounds -- \$40.50.
- 33 [(c) Notwithstanding any provision of this subtitle to the contrary, the
- 34 Administration may adopt a system of staggered registration for the following motor
- 35 vehicle classes: A, B, C, D, E (up to 7,000 pounds maximum gross vehicle weight), J,
- 36 L, 1A (dealer), 1B (motorcycle dealer), 1C (trailer dealer), 2 (recycler), 3 (finance
- 37 company), 4 (mobile equipment), 5 (transporter), and M.

- 1 (d) (1) During the registration period in which the system is initiated, 2 vehicle registrations may be issued for periods varying from 7 months to 18 months 3 with fees prorated according to the number of months for which the registration is 4 issued. Vehicle registration plates or validation tabs shall be issued and (2) 6 displayed in accordance with a schedule established by the Administrator. 7 Any new registration or renewal issued during the year may be 8 issued initially for other than a 12-month period to facilitate an equal volume of 9 monthly issuances. The registration fee will be prorated for the period issued. 10 For the purpose of maintaining relatively uniform work loads, 11 monthly volumes of registration renewals shall be evaluated from time to time and 12 any portion of a monthly issuance may be rescheduled by applying a different 13 expiration date and prorating the fee accordingly. 14 The refund of registration fees on surrender of the registration card 15 and unused registration plates provided in § 13-938 of this article shall be made to 16 the owner only if the return is made prior to the expiration date of the registration 17 period for which application for refund is made. 18 Whenever a prorated fee is assessed, the amount shall be calculated (6) 19 by multiplying one-twelfth of the applicable fee by the number of months for which 20 the issuance or renewal is made and the resultant figure shall be adjusted to the 21 nearest dollar amount.
- 22 (e) The Administration may adopt rules and regulations to implement and 23 operate a staggered registration system.]
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October 1, 1998.
