- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**
- 15 5-404.1.
- IN THIS SECTION, "OPERATION" MEANS THE FOLLOWING: 16 (A)
- THE BREAKING OF THE SURFACE SOIL IN ORDER TO FACILITATE OR 17 (1) 18 ACCOMPLISH THE EXTRACTION OR REMOVAL OF MINERALS:
- 19 ANY ACTIVITY OR PROCESS CONSTITUTING ALL OR PART OF A
- 20 PROCESS FOR THE EXTRACTION OR REMOVAL OF MINERALS FROM THEIR ORIGINAL
- 21 LOCATION; OR
- THE EXTRACTION OF SAND, GRAVEL, ROCK, STONE, EARTH, OR FILL 22
- 23 FROM BORROW PITS FOR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION PURPOSES OR OTHER PUBLIC
- 24 FACILITIES.
- 25 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:

- 1 (1) A MINING OPERATION THAT DOES NOT CONFORM TO FEDERAL, 2 STATE, OR LOCAL HEALTH OR ZONING REQUIREMENTS;
- 3 (2) A FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL AGENCY WHEN ENFORCING AIR, 4 WATER QUALITY, OR OTHER ENVIRONMENTAL STANDARDS UNDER FEDERAL, STATE,
- 5 OR LOCAL LAW; OR
- 6 (3) A MINING OPERATION THAT IS CONDUCTED IN A NEGLIGENT 7 MANNER.
- 8 (C) (1) IF A MINING OPERATION, INCLUDING ANY CHANGE IN THE 9 OPERATION, HAS BEEN UNDER WAY FOR A PERIOD OF 1 YEAR OR MORE AND IF THE
- 10 OPERATION OR THE CHANGE DID NOT CONSTITUTE A NUISANCE FROM THE DATE
- 11 THE OPERATION BEGAN OR THE DATE ON WHICH THE CHANGE IN THE OPERATION
- 12 BEGAN, THE MINING OPERATION MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED OR BECOME TO BE
- 13 CONSIDERED A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE NUISANCE.
- 14 (2) A PRIVATE ACTION AGAINST A MINING OPERATION THAT IS
- 15 DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE SUSTAINED ON
- 16 THE GROUNDS THAT THE OPERATION INTERFERES OR HAS INTERFERED WITH THE
- 17 USE OR ENJOYMENT OF OTHER PROPERTY, WHETHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 19 October 1, 1998.
