11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Health - General**

14 **SUBTITLE 9. HUMAN CLONING PROHIBITION.**

15 24-901.

16 STATE FUNDING MAY NOT BE PROVIDED TO ANY MEDICAL FACILITY, MEDICAL  
17 INSTITUTION, LABORATORY, PHYSICIANS, OR OTHER MEDICAL PERSONNEL FOR THE  
18 PURPOSE OF HUMAN CLONING EXPERIMENTS OR ATTEMPTS TO CLONE HUMAN  
19 BEINGS.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 1998.
