12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16	(a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay:
	(1) on a pro rata basis for the daily and nondaily State lottery games, the expenses of administering and operating the State lottery, as authorized under this subtitle and the State budget; and
20 21	(2) then, except as provided in § 10-113.1 of the Family Law Article and Article 27, § 810 of the Code, the holder of each winning ticket or share.
22 23	(b) (1) [Promptly] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, PROMPTLY after the 1st day of each month, the Comptroller shall pay:
