12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay:

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19 subtitle and the State budget; and
20 (2) then, except as provided in § 10-113.1 of the Family Law Article and 21 Article 27, § 810 of the Code, the holder of each winning ticket or share.

22 (b) (1) [Promptly] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS

4 (2) The money paid into the General Fund under this subsection is 5 available in the fiscal year in which the money accumulates in the State Lottery 6 Fund.

7 (C) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "UNANTICIPATED REVENUES" MEANS STATE 8 LOTTERY REVENUES THAT EXCEED BUDGETARY PROJECTIONS FOR A FISCAL YEAR.

9 (2) IF THE STATE LOTTERY RECEIVES UNANTICIPATED REVENUES FOR 10 A FISCAL YEAR, THE COMPTROLLER:

11 (I) MAY NOT DISTRIBUTE INTO THE GENERAL FUND ANY OF THE 12 UNANTICIPATED REVENUES; AND

13 (II) SHALL DISTRIBUTE TO EACH COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL 14 CORPORATION THE UNANTICIPATED REVENUES ON A PRO RATA BASIS ACCORDING 15 TO THE TOTAL LOTTERY SALES MADE IN EACH OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.
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SUBDIVISIONS REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, LOTTERY
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SALES MADE IN A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE

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21 [(c)] (D) The regulations of the Agency shall apportion the money in the State 22 Lottery Fund.
