- 16 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT DRIVE A MOTOR VEHICLE IN EXCESS OF 50% OF THE 17 POSTED SPEED LIMIT WHILE ATTEMPTING TO PASS A BICYCLE ON A HIGHWAY.
- 18 (B) A DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE MAY NOT FOLLOW WITHIN 25 FEET OF 19 ANY BICYCLE TRAVELING ON A HIGHWAY.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
