- 5 (b) An applicant for registration as a professional solicitor OR FIRE
- 6 ORGANIZATION SOLICITOR shall submit a consolidated bond for all of the officers,
- 7 agents, members, associate solicitors, subcontractors, and employees of the
- 8 professional solicitor OR FIRE ORGANIZATION SOLICITOR.
- 9 (c) An applicant for registration as a professional solicitor OR FIRE
- 10 ORGANIZATION SOLICITOR that submits a \$25,000 irrevocable letter of credit to the
- 11 Secretary of State is not required to submit a surety bond under subsection (a) of this
- 12 section.
- 13 (d) The Secretary of State may return a bond or irrevocable letter of credit
- 14 filed under this section only if:
- 15 (1) 3 years have passed since the registration period to which the bond or
- 16 letter applies, and there is no pending claim against the bond or letter; or

- 18 required accounting reports have been properly completed and filed, and it appears to
- 19 the satisfaction of the Secretary of State that the person is not in violation of the
- 20 Maryland Charitable Solicitations Act.

- 22 a professional solicitor OR FIRE ORGANIZATION SOLICITOR a notice that a person may
- 23 apply for return of a bond or irrevocable letter of credit after the registration period to
- 24 which the bond or letter applies.

- 28 register appropriately with the Secretary of State.

- 30 professional solicitor OR FIRE ORGANIZATION SOLICITOR unless the professional
- 31 solicitor OR FIRE ORGANIZATION SOLICITOR has applied to register with the
