16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

19 21-802.1.

20 (a) In this section, "highway work zone" means a construction or maintenance 21 area on or alongside a highway that is marked by appropriate warning signs or other 22 traffic control devices designating that work is in progress.

23 (b) The State Highway Administration OR, FOR HIGHWAYS UNDER ITS

24 JURISDICTION, THE HARFORD COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, may reduce

25 established speed limits in a highway work zone upon a determination that the

26 change is necessary to ensure the public safety.

1 (c) A speed limit established under this section shall become effective when 2 posted.

3 27-101.

4 (m) Any person who is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of § 5 21-802.1 of this article (Exceeding speed limit within highway work zone) is subject 6 to a fine of not more than \$1,000.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect8 October 1, 1998.
