4 FOR the purpose of providing that an executive order that adopts guidelines, rules of

- 6 shall apply to all State employees, except temporary employees, of all units in
- 7 the Judicial, Legislative, and Executive Branches of State government,

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article - State Personnel and Pensions

18 2-201.

19 (A) Except as otherwise provided by law, an employee in the Judicial,

20 Legislative, or Executive Branch of State government is governed by the laws and

21 personnel policies and procedures applicable in that branch.

(B) AN EXECUTIVE ORDER THAT ADOPTS GUIDELINES, RULES OF CONDUCT,
OR RULES OF PROCEDURE RELATING TO EMPLOYEE AND MANAGEMENT RELATIONS,
INCLUDING AN EXECUTIVE ORDER THAT AUTHORIZES OR ESTABLISHES A SYSTEM
OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING, SHALL APPLY TO ALL STATE EMPLOYEES, EXCEPT
TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES, OF ALL UNITS IN THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE, AND
JUDICIAL BRANCHES OF STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING ANY UNIT WITH AN
INDEPENDENT PERSONNEL SYSTEM.

 3 May 24, 1996, including Executive Order 01.01.1996.13.
