11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Education**

14 11-404.

15 THE COMMISSION SHALL PROHIBIT THE SOLICITATION OF CREDIT CARDS ON
16 THE CAMPUSES OF PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 1998.
