A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Fishing - Pound or Stake Nets

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring owners of certain pound or stake net poles to remove
- 4 them during certain dates, except under certain circumstances; requiring
- 5 owners of certain lights to keep them in good condition; altering the provisions
- 6 concerning penalties to provide for a revocation of eligibility to obtain a striped
- 7 bass allocation under certain circumstances; and generally relating to fishing
- 8 and pound or stake nets.
- 9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 10 Article Natural Resources
- 11 Section 4-711(h)
- 12 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 13 (1997 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Natural Resources

17 4-711.

- 18 (h) Every licensee shall maintain his stakes AND LIGHTS in good condition and
- 19 promptly remove and renew any stake that may be unsound, broken, or liable to go
- 20 adrift. A licensee may not permit or allow to remain in the water any pound or net
- 21 stake for a period greater than 30 days following the removal of the net from each
- 22 stake, or the discontinuance of fishing of the net AND MAY NOT PERMIT OR ALLOW
- 23 ANY POUND OR STAKE NET POLES TO REMAIN IN THE WATER BETWEEN JANUARY 1
- 24 AND JANUARY 31, UNLESS THE OWNER OF THE POUND NET NOTIFIES THE
- 25 DEPARTMENT THAT THE NET IS BEING ACTIVELY FISHED. [If the licensee does not
- 26 comply with the provision of this subsection, the Department immediately shall notify
- 27 him by certified mail, return receipt requested, bearing a postmark from the United
- 28 States Postal Service, to remove the stakes within 30 days after receipt of the notice.
- 29 If the A licensee WHO fails to comply with [this notice he] THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
- 30 SUBSECTION is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is subject to a fine of at

- 1 least \$200 and not exceeding \$1,000, with costs imposed in the discretion of the court,2 AND MAY NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO OBTAIN A STRIPED BASS ALLOCATION IN THE
- 3 FOLLOWING YEAR.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 1998.
