BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Natural Resources** 15 5-305. An approved applicant may receive cost-share assistance in the amount determined and approved by the Department, provided: No assistance may exceed 75 percent of the actual cost incurred by 19 the applicant in implementing the approved practice on a particular tract of land; 20 An eligible landowner may not receive more than \$5,000 in a 21 calendar year for all approved practices implemented by the landowner, unless the 22 owner has submitted a 3-year plan for woodland resource development under 23 paragraph (3) of this section; and

If the Department has approved a 3-year plan for woodland resource

25 development, an eligible landowner may not receive more than \$15,000 during the

26 3-year period for all approved practices implemented by the landowner.

- 1 (4) A FEE CHARGED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR COST-SHARE AND
- 2 TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE IT MAY RENDER THE LANDOWNER IN IMPLEMENTING
- 3 APPROVED FORESTRY PRACTICES MAY NOT EXCEED \$10 FOR EACH AFFECTED ACRE
- 4 DURING A 6-MONTH PERIOD.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 1998.
