BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Natural Resources** 16 5-305. 17 An approved applicant may receive cost-share assistance in the amount determined and approved by the Department, provided: 19 No assistance may exceed 75 percent of the actual cost incurred by (1) 20 the applicant in implementing the approved practice on a particular tract of land; An eligible landowner may not receive more than \$5,000 in a 21 22 calendar year for all approved practices implemented by the landowner, unless the 23 owner has submitted a 3-year plan for woodland resource development under 24 paragraph (3) of this section; [and]

If the Department has approved a 3-year plan for woodland resource

26 development, an eligible landowner may not receive more than \$15,000 during the 27 3-year period for all approved practices implemented by the landowner; AND
