1 AN ACT concerning	
2	Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Beer and Wine Tasting

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners
- to issue certain beer and wine tasting licenses; limiting the number of licenses
- that can be issued annually; authorizing the Board to issue certain licenses to 5
- 6 certain licensees; requiring the Board to set a fee for a license; specifying certain
- amounts of alcoholic beverages that a licensee may serve under a license; 7
- 8 requiring a licensee to dispose of certain unconsumed alcoholic beverages;
- 9 making certain provisions of law not applicable to a licensee; setting certain
- 10 times that a licensee may use a license; and generally relating to beer and wine

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 22
- 23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 2 8-403.
- 3 (a) The Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners may issue a WS (wine 4 sampling) license to bona fide nonprofit organizations.
- 5 (b) The fee for this license is \$15 per day.
- 6 (c) The Board of License Commissioners may not grant more than 12 WS 7 licenses to any 1 bona fide nonprofit organization in each license year.
- 8 (d) Application shall be made for this license at least 15 days before the date 9 on which the license is issued.
- 10 (e) The WS license permits the transportation of wine and the consumption of 11 wine for sampling purposes:
- 12 (1) On a Class B or Class B-D-7 licensed premises with the 13 authorization of the respective holder; or
- 14 (2) On a premises that is not permanently licensed under this article.
- 15 (f) A holder may not serve more than 2 ounces of wine from a given brand to 16 any one person.

- 18 (A) THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A 19 1-DAY CLASS BWT BEER AND WINE (ON-PREMISES) TASTING LICENSE.
- 20 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A MAXIMUM OF 12 CLASS BWT LICENSES PER 21 YEAR.
- 22 (C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A CLASS BWT LICENSE ONLY TO A CLASS A BEER 23 AND LIGHT WINE LICENSEE OR A CLASS A BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSEE.
- 24 (D) (1) THE BOARD SHALL SET A FEE FOR A CLASS BWT LICENSE.
- 25 (2) THE FEE FOR A CLASS BWT LICENSE IS IN ADDITION TO THE CLASS A 26 LICENSE ANNUAL FEE.
- 27 (E) A HOLDER OF A CLASS BWT LICENSE MAY PERMIT ON-PREMISES
- 28 CONSUMPTION OF THE FOLLOWING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR TASTING OR
- 29 SAMPLING PURPOSES ONLY:
- 30 (1) LIGHT WINE, SERVED IN A QUANTITY OF NOT MORE THAN 1 OUNCE 31 FROM A GIVEN BRAND TO ANY ONE PERSON; AND
- 32 (2) BEER, SERVED IN A QUANTITY OF NOT MORE THAN 3 OUNCES FROM
- 33 A GIVEN BRAND TO ANY ONE PERSON.

- 1 (F) AT THE END OF THE DAY FOR WHICH A LICENSE IS VALID, A HOLDER OF A
- 2 CLASS BWT LICENSE SHALL DISPOSE OF UNCONSUMED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
- 3 REMAINING IN A CONTAINER OPENED FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING.
- 4 (G) A CLASS BWT LICENSEE IS NOT RESTRICTED BY:
- 5 (1) § 12-107(B) OF THIS ARTICLE; OR
- 6 (2) § 9-102 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 7 (H) A CLASS BWT LICENSEE MAY EXERCISE THE PRIVILEGES UNDER THE
- 8 CLASS BWT LICENSE ONLY DURING THE HOURS AND DAYS PROVIDED FOR UNDER
- 9 THE RESPECTIVE CLASS A LICENSE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 October 1, 1998.
