1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Personnel - Family and Medical Leave**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain provision of law to allow, and not require,
4 regulations adopted by the Secretary of Budget and Management implementing
5 the federal Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 to require eligible State
6 employees to use other available accrued leave concurrently with family and
7 medical leave; and generally relating to family and medical leave.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

16 9-1001.

17 (a) The Secretary shall adopt regulations, guidelines, or policies implementing
18 the federal Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993.

19 (b) The regulations adopted by the Secretary [shall] MAY require an eligible
20 employee to use other available accrued leave concurrently with family and medical
21 leave.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 1998.
