16 17	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1	(a) On or before December 1 of each year, the Committee shall submit, subject to § 2-1246 of this article, to the Legislative Policy Committee and the Governor a report with recommendations on fiscal goals for the State budget to be considered at the next regular session of the General Assembly, including:

14	(2) a recommended level of new debt authorization;
15	(3) a recommended level of State personnel;
16	(4) A RECOMMENDED PLAN TO ADDRESS A PROJECTED DEFICIT;
