16 17 18 19 20 21 22	(a) The Office of Public Defender is hereby established in the Executive Branch of the government of the State of Maryland. The head of the Office shall be the Public Defender, who shall be appointed by the board of trustees, and who shall serve at the pleasure of the board of trustees. To be qualified for appointment as Public Defender, a person must be an attorney-at-law, admitted to practice law in the State of Maryland by the Court of Appeals of Maryland, and engaged in the practice of law for a period of five (5) years prior to his appointment. The Public Defender shall receive [such salary as provided in the budget, and shall] THE SAME SALARY AS AN ASSOCIATE JUDGE OF A CIRCUIT COURT. THE PUBLIC DEFENDER MAY not engage in the private practice of law.		

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1998.
