- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 This subtitle applies to: (a)
- 16 Affected property; and (1)
- 17 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (b) of this section, any residential rental
- 18 property, the owner of which elects to comply with this subtitle.
- 19 This subtitle does not apply to: (b)
- 20 (1) Property not expressly covered in subsection (a) of this section;
- 21 (2) Affected property owned or operated by a unit of federal, State, or
- 22 local government, or any public, quasi-public, or municipal corporation, if the
- 23 affected property is subject to lead standards that are equal to, or more stringent
- 24 than, the risk reduction standard established under § 6-815 of this subtitle; [or]

- 1 (3) Affected property which is certified to be lead-free pursuant to \S 2 6-804 of this subtitle; OR
- 3 (4) AFFECTED PROPERTY THAT IS LOCATED IN AN AREA ZONED 4 PRIMARILY FOR AGRICULTURAL OR CONSERVATION USES.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 1998.
