A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Workplace Safety and Health Research Fund

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Workplace Safety and Health Research Fund;
- 4 specifying the purpose of the Workplace Safety and Health Research Fund;
- 5 providing that the Workplace Safety and Health Research Fund shall be
- 6 administered by the Division of Labor and Industry; specifying the nature of the
- Workplace Safety and Health Research Fund; and generally relating to the
- 8 Workplace Safety and Health Research Fund.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Labor and Employment
- 17 5-608.
- 18 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH 19 RESEARCH FUND.
- 20 (B) THE FUND SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DIVISION.
- 21 (C) (1) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS OR LOANS TO
- 22 PERSONS FOR RESEARCH ON OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH AND TO IMPROVE
- 23 OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH FOR WORKERS.
- 24 (2) NO MONEYS MAY BE EXPENDED BY THE FUND UNTIL THE DIVISION
- 25 HAS ADOPTED REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION,
- 26 INCLUDING QUALIFICATIONS FOR OBTAINING A LOAN OR A GRANT UNDER THIS
- 27 SECTION.

- 1 (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT 2 TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- 3 (2) THE TREASURER SHALL SEPARATELY HOLD AND THE COMPTROLLER 4 SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- 5 (3) THE FUND SHALL BE INVESTED AND REINVESTED IN THE SAME 6 MANNER AS OTHER STATE FUNDS.
- 7 (4) THE FUND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO AN AUDIT BY THE OFFICE OF 8 LEGISLATIVE AUDITS AS PROVIDED FOR IN § 2-1220 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT 9 ARTICLE.
- $10~\rm{(E)}~\rm{(1)}~\rm{THE}~\rm{FUND}~\rm{MAY}~\rm{RECEIVE}~\rm{MONEY}~\rm{OR}~\rm{OTHER}~\rm{CONTRIBUTIONS}~\rm{FROM}~\rm{11}~\rm{ANY}~\rm{SOURCE}.$
- 12 (2) ANY COST FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FUND MAY BE PAID 13 FROM THE FUND.
- 14 (F) (1) MONEYS FROM THE FUND MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED BY BUDGET 15 AMENDMENT OR OTHERWISE TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE OR FOR ANY 16 OTHER PURPOSES.
- 17 (2) MONEYS APPROPRIATED OR CREDITED TO THE FUND MAY NOT 18 REVERT TO THE REVENUE STABILIZATION ACCOUNT.
- 19 (G) BEFORE JANUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE DIVISION SHALL REPORT TO THE
- 20 GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE
- 21 GENERAL ASSEMBLY CONCERNING THE FINANCIAL STATUS OF THE FUND AND THE
- 22 DISBURSEMENTS FOR THE PRECEDING YEAR.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 1998.
