- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (A) THE MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT FORMULA FOR NURSING FACILITY
- 4 SERVICES, AS SET FORTH IN THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS, SHALL
- 5 PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TARGET OCCUPANCY PERCENTAGE FOR
- 6 EACH FISCAL YEAR FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING AMOUNTS PAYABLE TO
- 7 SUCH FACILITIES FOR CAPITAL, ADMINISTRATIVE, AND OTHER COSTS NOT DIRECTLY
- 8 ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE PROVISION OF RESIDENT CARE.
- 9 (B) THE TARGET OCCUPANCY PERCENTAGE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (A) OF
- 10 THIS SECTION FOR ANY FISCAL YEAR SHALL BE EQUAL TO THE MEAN PERCENTAGE
- 11 OF OCCUPIED BEDS OF ALL NURSING FACILITIES IN THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING
- 12 FISCAL YEAR, MINUS THREE PERCENTAGE POINTS.
- 13 (C) HOWEVER, IF A NURSING FACILITY'S OCCUPANCY IS LESS THAN THAT
- 14 SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THEN THAT FACILITY SHALL BE
- 15 REIMBURSED AT THE STATE AVERAGE MINUS THREE PERCENTAGE POINTS.
- 16 (D) IF A NURSING FACILITY'S OCCUPANCY IS GREATER THAN THAT SPECIFIED
- 17 IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THEN THAT FACILITY SHALL BE REIMBURSED
- 18 BASED ON ITS ACTUAL OCCUPANCY Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in
- 19 consultation with the health care industry, shall study the feasibility of altering the
- 20 payment parameters, structure, and target occupancy percentage that is currently
- 21 used in the Medicaid reimbursement formula for nursing facility services as set forth
- 22 in the Code of Maryland Regulations. For the purpose of determining amounts
- 23 payable to nursing facilities for capital, administrative, and other costs not directly
- 24 <u>attributable to the provision of resident care</u>, the Department shall consider amounts
- 25 that will more accurately reflect current market costs and appropriate nursing home
- 26 capacity. The Department shall report on the results of its study and on its
- 27 recommendation for altering the payment parameters, structure, and target
- 28 occupancy percentage to the Senate Finance Committee, the House Environmental
- 29 Matters Committee, and in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government
- 30 Article, the General Assembly on or before December 1, 1998.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 32 June 1, 1998.
