- 1 (B) THE TARGET OCCUPANCY PERCENTAGE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (A) OF
- 2 THIS SECTION FOR ANY FISCAL YEAR SHALL BE EQUAL TO THE MEAN PERCENTAGE
- 3 OF OCCUPIED BEDS OF ALL NURSING FACILITIES IN THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING
- 4 FISCAL YEAR, MINUS THREE PERCENTAGE POINTS.
- 5 (C) HOWEVER, IF A NURSING FACILITY'S OCCUPANCY IS LESS THAN THAT
