2 Baltimore City - The Eubie Blake National Jazz Institute and Cultural
3 Center Loan of 1994

- 4 FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 220 of the Acts of the General Assembly of
- 5 1994, the Baltimore City Eubie Blake National Museum and Cultural Center
- 6 Loan of 1994, as amended by Chapter 322 of the Acts of the General Assembly of
- 7 1995, as amended by Chapter 12 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1996, to
- 8 alter the title of the loan and the name of the institution that is to be the
- 9 recipient of the proceeds of the bonds to be The Eubie Blake National Jazz
- 10 Institute and Cultural Center, to alter the location of the Center to be 847 North
- Howard Street in Baltimore City, and to alter the use of the proceeds of the
- bonds.
- 13 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 14 Chapter 220 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994, as amended by
- 15 Chapter 322 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1995, as amended by
- 16 Chapter 12 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1996
- 17 Section 1
- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Chapter 220 of the Acts of 1994, as amended by Chapter 322 of the Acts of 1995, as amended by Chapter 12 of the Acts of 1996
- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 23 MARYLAND, That:
- 24 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 25 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as [the]THE Eubie
- 26 Blake National [Museum] JAZZ INSTITUTE and Cultural Center Loan of 1994 in a
- 27 total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$250,000 or (ii) the amount of the
- 28 matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be
- 29 evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds
- 30 authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and

- 1 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 2 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 3 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 4 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 5 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 6 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 7 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 8 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 9 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 10 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 11 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to [the] THE Eubie Blake National
- 12 [Museum] JAZZ INSTITUTE and Cultural Center, Inc. for the [razing of an existing
- 13 building and the planning, design, construction, and equipping of a new building at
- 14 Franklin and Howard Streets in Baltimore City, to be used as the Eubie Blake
- 15 National Museum and Cultural Center.] REPAIR, RENOVATION, RECONSTRUCTION,
- 16 CONSTRUCTION, AND CAPITAL EQUIPPING OF A BUILDING AT 847 NORTH HOWARD
- 17 STREET IN BALTIMORE CITY TO BE NAMED IN HONOR OF EUBIE BLAKE AND TO BE
- 18 USED AS A MODERN PERFORMING ARTS CENTER THAT WOULD BE A HOME FOR THE
- 19 WORK OF MINORITY ARTISTS AND WOULD PROVIDE AREA RESIDENTS WITH CLASSES
- 20 AND ACTIVITIES IN THE ARTS.
- 21 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 22 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and
- 23 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 24 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 25 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 26 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the Eubie Blake National Museum and
- 27 Cultural Center, Inc. shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of an
- 28 applicant's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of
- 29 the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of
- 30 real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of
- 31 this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money
- 32 or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine
- 33 the matter and the Board's decision is final. The Eubie Blake National [Museum]
- 34 JAZZ INSTITUTE and Cultural Center, Inc. has until June 1, 1996, to present evidence
- 35 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If
- 36 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of
- 37 the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the
- 38 amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.
- 39 Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the
- 40 Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 41 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 42 June 1, 1998.
