FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Fire Marshal from collecting a certain fee for conducting an inspection of property that is owned by the State, <u>a</u> county, <u>a</u> municipal corporation, <u>or a nonprofit entity or certain fire, rescue, or emergency medical services entities</u> ; and generally relating to the State Fire Marshal.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (m) (1) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 17 SUBSECTION, THE State Fire Marshal shall:
18 [(1)] (I) Collect the fees established by the State Fire Prevention 19 Commission for conducting inspections;
20 [(2)] (II) Keep records of all fees collected under this subsection; and

- 1 [(3)] (III) Pay all moneys collected under this subsection into the General 2 Fund of the State.

- 7 (II) A FIRE, RESCUE, OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ENTITY,
