## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 State Comptroller's Office - Investigative Services Unit

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that employees of the Investigative Services Unit of the
- 4 State Comptroller's Office who are sworn officers shall be subject to the same
- salary plan, including grades, steps, and increments based on length of service,
- 6 as Maryland State <del>Police officers</del> <u>Police troopers</u>; requiring a certain pay scale
- 7 parity between Maryland State Police officers Police troopers and sworn officers
- 8 of the Investigative Services Unit of the State Comptroller's Office be
- 9 reestablished as of a certain date to provide for a certain comparability; and
- relating generally to the salaries of certain employees of the Investigative
- 11 Services Unit of the State Comptroller's Office.

- 13 Article Tax General
- 14 Section 2-107.1
- 15 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 16 (1997 Replacement Volume)
- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 1 Article - Tax - General

- 2 2-107.1.
- 3 (A) EMPLOYEES OF THE INVESTIGATIVE SERVICES UNIT OF THE
- 4 COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE WHO ARE SWORN POLICE OFFICERS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO
- 5 THE SAME SALARY PLAN, INCLUDING GRADES, STEPS, AND INCREMENTS BASED ON
- 6 LENGTH OF SERVICE, AS MARYLAND STATE POLICE OFFICERS POLICE TROOPERS.
- 7 (B) WHENEVER MARYLAND STATE POLICE OFFICERS POLICE TROOPERS
- 8 RECEIVE A SALARY, GRADE, OR STEP INCREASE, EMPLOYEES OF THE INVESTIGATIVE
- 9 SERVICES UNIT OF THE COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE WHO ARE SWORN POLICE OFFICERS
- 10 SHALL RECEIVE AN EQUAL SALARY, GRADE, OR STEP INCREASE.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the pay scale parity
- 12 that existed between Maryland State Police officers Police troopers and sworn officers
- 13 of the Investigative Services Unit of the State Comptroller's Office on June 30, 1997,
- 14 shall be reestablished by adjusting the salary scale of the sworn police officers of the
- 15 Investigative Services Unit to match the comparable ranks of Maryland State Police
- 16 officers Police troopers. For the purposes of this Act, comparable ranks between the
- $17\,$  sworn police officers of the Investigative Services Unit and Maryland State Police
- 18 officers Police troopers, reflecting similar duties and responsibilities, are as follows:
- 19 (1) Agent I is comparable to Officer Trooper;
- 20 (2) Agent II is comparable to Officer Trooper First Class;
- 21 (3) Agent III is comparable to Corporal;
- 22 (4) Administrative Agent is comparable to Sergeant; and
- 23 (5) Agent in Charge is comparable to Lieutenant.
- 24 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 25 effect July 1, 1998.
