2 Somerset County Board of Education - Appointment <u>Selection</u> of Members - <u>Straw Ballot</u> 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to appoint the members of the Somerset 5 County Board of Education in accordance with certain procedures; specifying

26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

30 (a) Except for the New Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners

31 established under § 3-108.1 of this subtitle and counties listed in § 3-114 of this

32 subtitle, the Governor shall appoint the members of each county board from the

33 residents of that county.

35 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE 36 SOMERSET COUNTY BOARD.

1 (B) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED FROM EACH COUNTY 2 COMMISSIONER DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY.

3 (C) (1) THERE IS A SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING COMMISSION IN EACH 4 COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY.

5 (2) THE PURPOSE OF EACH NOMINATING COMMISSION IS TO SELECT A
6 CANDIDATE FROM THE COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT TO BE RECOMMENDED TO
7 THE GOVERNOR AS QUALIFIED TO FILL A POSITION OR VACANCY ON THE COUNTY
8 BOARD.

9 (D) EACH NOMINATING COMMISSION CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING FIVE 10 MEMBERS:

11 (1) A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE 12 OF SOMERSET COUNTY;

13 (2) A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE 14 OF SOMERSET COUNTY;

15 (3) A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 16 SOMERSET COUNTY;

17 (4) A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE COUNTYWIDE TEACHERS'
 18 ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING A MAJORITY OF TEACHERS IN SOMERSET COUNTY
 19 FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING PURPOSES; AND

(5) A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDING OFFICERS OF THE
 COUNTYWIDE PARENTS AND TEACHERS ASSOCIATION REPRESENTING A MAJORITY
 OF PARENTS AND TEACHERS IN SOMERSET COUNTY.

23 (E) THE SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING COMMISSIONS SHALL JOINTLY AGREE 24 ON RULES TO GOVERN THEIR PROCEEDINGS.

25 (F) (1) IF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF A NOMINATING COMMISSION
26 VOTE IN FAVOR OF ONE CANDIDATE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THAT
27 CANDIDATE.

28 (2) IF NO CANDIDATE RECEIVES A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES OF THE
 29 NOMINATING COMMISSION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBER OF THE
 30 BOARD FROM THE RESIDENTS OF THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY COMMISSIONER
 31 DISTRICT.

32 (G) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE 33 TERMS OF MEMBERS SERVING ON JULY 1, 1999.

34 (H) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNTY BOARD IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE \$3,000
 35 ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION, AND THE OTHER MEMBERS ARE ENTITLED TO
 36 RECEIVE \$2,700 EACH ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for the purpose of

11 implementing the transition from an elected Board to an appointed Board, the terms
12 of elected members of the Somerset County Board of Education serving on June 30,
13 1999 shall expire as follows:

14 (1) The member elected from Commissioner District 1 on June 30, 1999;

15 (2) The member elected from Commissioner District 2 on June 30, 2000;

16 (3) The member elected from Commissioner District 3 on June 30, 2001;

17 (4) The member elected from Commissioner District 4 on June 30, 2002; and

18 (5) The member elected from Commissioner District 5 on June 30, 2003.

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, before this Act becomes

20 effective, it shall first be submitted to a referendum of the legally qualified voters of

21 Somerset County at the general election to be held in November 1998. The Board of

22 County Commissioners and the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Somerset County

23 shall do those things necessary and proper to provide for and hold the referendum

24 required by this section. If a majority of the votes cast on the question are "For the

25 referred law" the provisions of this Act shall become effective on the 30th day

26 following the official canvass of votes for the referendum, but if a majority of the votes

27 cast on the question are "Against the referred law" the provisions of this Act are of no
 28 effect and null and void.

29 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions

30 of Section 3 of this Act and for the sole purpose of providing for the referendum

31 required by Section 3, this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

32 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

33 MARYLAND, That under the provisions of Article 33 - Election Code of the Annotated

34 Code of Maryland, the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Somerset County, in

35 consultation with the State Board of Elections, shall prepare and include on the ballot

36 *for the November general election of 1998 the following question:*

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1 "Do you favor changing the method of selection of the members of the Somerset

2 <u>County Board of Education from election by the voters of Somerset County to</u>

3 appointment by the Governor?"

4 <u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That the Board of Supervisors

5 of Elections of Somerset County and the Board of County Commissioners of Somerset

6 County shall do those things necessary and proper to place this question on the ballot

7 prepared for the November general election of 1998, so that each participating voter in

8 the County may have the opportunity to cast a vote on the question. The question shall

9 <u>be proposed, presented, and tallied, and reported in general accordance with the</u>
10 <u>provisions of Article 33 of the Annotated Code. The vote on this question is advisory</u>

12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
