19 20	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY" MEANS:

- 1 (1) THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR AN AGENCY OR INSTRUMENTALITY 2 OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT:
- 3 (2) THE STATE GOVERNMENT, ANOTHER STATE, OR AN AGENCY OR 4 INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE STATE OR ANOTHER STATE; OR
- 5 (3) ANOTHER COUNTY, A MUNICIPALITY, OR OTHER POLITICAL
- 6 SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OR OF ANOTHER STATE OR AN INSTRUMENTALITY OF A
- 7 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION.
- 8 (B) WHENEVER THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DETERMINE THAT IT IS IN THE 9 BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:
