- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 IN THIS SECTION, "PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY" MEANS A PERSON THAT THE
- 24 MARYLAND APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING COUNCIL APPROVES UNDER § 11-405(B)

- 3 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE
- 4 PROGRAM IS TO DEVELOP A WELL-TRAINED, PRODUCTIVE CONSTRUCTION
- 5 WORKFORCE WHICH MEETS THE NEEDS OF THE STATE'S ECONOMY.
- 6 (D) THE DIVISION SHALL ADMINISTER THE CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP 7 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
- 8 (E) AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET, THE CONSTRUCTION
- 9 APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL AWARD GRANTS TO ELIGIBLE
- 10 PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITIES THAT OPERATE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS IN THE
- 11 STATE.
- 12 (F) THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT 13 THIS SECTION.
- 14 (G) BY REGULATION, THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH:
- 15 (1) CRITERIA TO DETERMINE THE ELIGIBILITY OF PRIVATE SECTOR 16 ENTITIES: AND
- 17 (2) AN APPLICATION PROCESS FOR DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY.
- 18 (H) A GRANT AWARDED BY THE CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP
- 19 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE BASED
- 20 ON THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS IN A PROGRAM OPERATED BY AN ELIGIBLE
- 21 PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY.
- 22 (I) A GRANT SHALL CONSIST OF A MAXIMUM OF \$1,000 FOR EACH APPRENTICE
- 23 IN AN ELIGIBLE PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY.
- 24 (J) THE CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL
- 25 DISTRIBUTE A GRANT AWARDED TO A PRIVATE SECTOR ENTITY:
- 26 (1) AT THE END OF A PROGRAM YEAR; AND
- 27 (2) ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT EACH APPRENTICE HAS COMPLETED 28 THE PROGRAM YEAR.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 30 October 1, 1998.
