- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 14 12-302.
- 15 (a) Unless provision is made elsewhere, the following provisions apply
- 16 statewide to persons who are employed in licensed establishments:
- 17 (1) A person under age 18 may not be [employed] ENGAGED in the sale 18 of alcoholic beverages.
- 19 (2) Except for Class D beer, wine and liquor licensees as provided in
- 20 paragraph (3) of this subsection, a person between ages 18 and 21 may be employed in
- 21 the sale of beer and light wine.
- 22 (3) A person under age 21 may not be employed by any holder of a Class
- 23 D beer, wine and liquor license in the sale of alcoholic beverages.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 1998.
