4 FOR the purpose of requiring a principal of a certain school and the operator or owner

(D) (1) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS

OPERATOR OR OWNER OF A CHILD CARE CENTER MAY AUTHORIZE A PESTICIDE
APPLICATION ONLY ON THE DATES, IN THE GENERAL LOCATION, AND USING THE
PESTICIDES SPECIFIED IN THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(2)(II) AND
(III) OF THIS SECTION.

(II) IF THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL OR OPERATOR OR OWNER OF A
CHILD CARE CENTER INTENDS TO AUTHORIZE A PESTICIDE APPLICATION, ON A
DATE, IN A LOCATION, OR USING A PESTICIDE OTHER THAN AS SPECIFIED IN
SUBSECTION (C)(2)(II) OR (III) OF THIS SECTION, THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL OR CHILD
CARE CENTER OPERATOR OR OWNER SHALL NOTIFY PARENTS, GUARDIANS, AND
STAFF OF THE CHANGE IN THE MANNER THAT THE NOTICE IS REQUIRED TO BE SENT

5 REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY ARISING FROM A
6 FAILURE OF A STUDENT TO DELIVER A NOTICE TO A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.
