## 2 Volunteer Firefighters and Rescue Squad Personnel - Disablement Pension

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that the Board of Trustees of the Maryland State
- 4 Firemen's Association pay a certain pension to a person who is a volunteer
- 5 firefighter or individual serving on a volunteer rescue squad who is disabled
- 6 under certain circumstances, regardless of the district in which the person was
- disabled or whether the person was disabled while acting alone or at the
- 8 direction of or with a fire company or rescue squad in this State or certain
- 9 neighboring states; and generally relating to pensions for volunteer firefighters
- and individuals who serve on volunteer rescue squads.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 23 Article 38A Fires and Investigations
- 24 [42.
- 25 Whenever any volunteer fireman or volunteer rescue squadman in good
- 26 standing of an incorporated volunteer fire company or volunteer rescue squad in the

- 1 State of Maryland, is temporarily or permanently disabled as a direct result from
- 2 active participation in fighting a fire or while going to or from a fire, performing any
- 3 other duties necessary to the operation or maintenance of the fire company, or
- 4 actively participating in the ambulance or rescue squad work of an incorporated
- 5 volunteer fire company or volunteer rescue squad in the State, the fireman or rescue
- 6 squadman shall lay his case before the board of trustees of the Maryland State
- 7 Firemen's Association, supported in all cases by the recommendation of the fire
- 8 company or volunteer rescue squad of which he is a member, and the board of trustees
- 9 shall proceed to consider it. If the facts are found as stated, the name of the fireman
- 10 or rescue squadman shall be placed on a list to be kept by the secretary of the
- 11 Maryland State Firemen's Association, to be known as "Disabled Firemen's and
- 12 Rescue Squadmen's List", and every person placed on the list shall be entitled to
- 13 receive a pension from the Maryland State Firemen's Association in a sum, the
- 14 amount of which shall be decided upon by the board of trustees of the Maryland State
- 15 Firemen's Association and to be paid out of its treasury at whatever times, in
- 16 whatever installments and in whatever amounts as the board of trustees of the
- 17 Maryland State Firemen's Association may decide, during the period he is disabled or
- 18 so long as the pensioner is without other means of comfortable support.]

- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BOARD" MEANS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
- 21 MARYLAND STATE FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION.
- 22 (B) A PERSON WHO IS A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER OR INDIVIDUAL SERVING
- 23 ON A VOLUNTEER RESCUE SQUAD IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A PENSION FROM THE
- 24 BOARD IF:
- 25 (1) THE PERSON IS TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY DISABLED:
- 26 (I) AS A DIRECT RESULT OF ACTIVELY PARTICIPATING IN
- 27 FIGHTING A FIRE OR WHILE GOING TO OR FROM A FIRE;
- 28 (II) WHILE PERFORMING ANY OTHER DUTIES NECESSARY TO THE
- 29 OPERATION OR MAINTENANCE OF THE FIRE COMPANY; OR
- 30 (III) WHILE ACTIVELY PARTICIPATING IN THE AMBULANCE,
- 31 ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT, OR RESCUE WORK OF A VOLUNTEER FIRE, AMBULANCE,
- 32 OR RESCUE COMPANY OR VOLUNTEER ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT UNIT IN THE
- 33 STATE; AND
- 34 (2) THE PERSON IS SUPPORTED BY THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE
- 35 FIRE COMPANY OR VOLUNTEER RESCUE SQUAD OF WHICH THE PERSON IS A
- 36 MEMBER.
- 37 (C) A PENSION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID FROM THE TREASURY
- 38 OF THE MARYLAND STATE FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION IN AN AMOUNT AND IN A
- 39 MANNER THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES FOR AS LONG AS THE PENSIONER IS
- 40 DISABLED OR WITHOUT OTHER MEANS OF COMFORTABLE SUPPORT.

## **HOUSE BILL 1205**

- 1 (D) A PENSION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID TO A PENSIONER 2 REGARDLESS OF: 3 (1) THE DISTRICT IN WHICH THE PENSIONER WAS DISABLED; WHETHER THE PENSIONER WAS DISABLED WHILE ACTING ALONE (2) 5 OR AT THE DIRECTION OF OR WITH A FIRE, AMBULANCE, OR RESCUE COMPANY OR 6 ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT UNIT IN: 7 (I) THIS STATE; 8 (II) ONE OF THE FOLLOWING ADJACENT STATES - DELAWARE, 9 PENNSYLVANIA, WEST VIRGINIA, VIRGINIA; OR 10 (III) THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA. 11 (E) THE SECRETARY OF THE BOARD SHALL PLACE AND KEEP THE NAME OF 12 EACH PENSIONER UNDER THIS SECTION ON A DISABLED FIREMEN'S AND RESCUE
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 1998.
