#### **HOUSE BILL 1205**

# 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## Article 38A - Fires and Investigations

4 [42.

5 Whenever any volunteer fireman or volunteer rescue squadman in good 6 standing of an incorporated volunteer fire company or volunteer rescue squad in the 7 State of Maryland, is temporarily or permanently disabled as a direct result from 8 active participation in fighting a fire or while going to or from a fire, performing any 9 other duties necessary to the operation or maintenance of the fire company, or 10 actively participating in the ambulance or rescue squad work of an incorporated 11 volunteer fire company or volunteer rescue squad in the State, the fireman or rescue 12 squadman shall lay his case before the board of trustees of the Maryland State 13 Firemen's Association, supported in all cases by the recommendation of the fire 14 company or volunteer rescue squad of which he is a member, and the board of trustees 15 shall proceed to consider it. If the facts are found as stated, the name of the fireman 16 or rescue squadman shall be placed on a list to be kept by the secretary of the 17 Maryland State Firemen's Association, to be known as "Disabled Firemen's and 18 Rescue Squadmen's List", and every person placed on the list shall be entitled to 19 receive a pension from the Maryland State Firemen's Association in a sum, the 20 amount of which shall be decided upon by the board of trustees of the Maryland State 21 Firemen's Association and to be paid out of its treasury at whatever times, in 22 whatever installments and in whatever amounts as the board of trustees of the

23 Maryland State Firemen's Association may decide, during the period he is disabled or

24 so long as the pensioner is without other means of comfortable support.]
