## **Charter Counties - Legislative Powers - Expansion of Authority** 3 FOR the purpose of expanding the authority of counties that have adopted charter home rule by authorizing the governing body of the county to enact legislation on any subject matter to the extent that the General Assembly has authorized another charter county to legislate on the subject matter, subject to specified limitations; providing that the authority may not be construed in a specified manner; and generally relating to the legislative authority of counties that have adopted charter home rule. 10 BY adding to Article 25A - Chartered Counties of Maryland Section 5B Annotated Code of Maryland 14 (1996 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article 25A - Chartered Counties of Maryland 18 5B. (A) IN ADDITION TO ANY POWER THAT A CHARTER COUNTY MAY HAVE UNDER 20 PUBLIC GENERAL OR PUBLIC LOCAL LAW, AND SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE 21 COUNTY'S CHARTER, THE GOVERNING BODY OF A CHARTER COUNTY MAY ENACT 22 LOCAL LEGISLATION ON ANY SUBJECT MATTER: TO THE EXTENT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZES ANOTHER (1)24 CHARTER COUNTY TO LEGISLATE ON THE SUBJECT MATTER; AND THAT IS NOT COVERED BY THE EXPRESS POWERS GRANTED TO THE (2)26 COUNTY UNDER § 5 OF THIS ARTICLE. THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED AS PART OF THE EXPRESS **(B)** 28 POWERS ACT FOR PURPOSES OF ARTICLE XI-A, § 4 OF THE CONSTITUTION.
