By: Delegates Muse and Bozman Introduced and read first time: February 13, 1998 Assigned to: Appropriations A BILL ENTITLED 1 AN ACT concerning 2 State Personnel - Skilled Service and Professional Service - Layoffs 3 FOR the purpose of providing that a State employee is deemed to have been laid off when the employee is separated from a position in the skilled service or 4 5 professional service because of certain actions relating to the elimination or 6 reduction of budget funds; requiring the Secretary of Budget and Management to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to layoffs of State employees. 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 8 Article - State Personnel and Pensions 10 Section 11-201 through 11-203 and 11-302 Annotated Code of Maryland 11 (1997 Replacement Volume) 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 16 11-201. 17 (a) Except as otherwise provided by law, this subtitle only applies to (1) 18 skilled service and professional service employees in the State Personnel 19 Management System. 20 (2) The procedures in this subtitle do not apply to: 21 (i) a disciplinary action under Subtitle 1 of this title; 22 a termination [or separation] from employment under 23 [Subtitle 3] § 11-303 of this title; or

special appointees.

This subtitle does not prevent the layoff of an employee who submits to the

26 head of the employee's principal unit a written request to be laid off.

- 2 (A) The Secretary shall adopt regulations to provide procedures that are 3 uniform among the principal units for:
- 4 (1) the layoff of employees in the skilled service or the professional
- 5 service; and

- 6 (2) the reinstatement of laid-off and separated skilled service or
- 7 professional service employees to comparable positions in State employment.
- 8 (B) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT REQUIRE WRITTEN
- 9 NOTICE TO BE GIVEN TO EACH EMPLOYEE WHO IS LAID OFF UNDER § 11-203(B) OF
- 10 THIS SUBTITLE AT LEAST 60 DAYS BEFORE THE LAYOFF.

- 12 (A) An employee shall be laid off if the employee is in a position that will be
- 13 abolished, discontinued, or vacated because of a change in organization or because of
- 14 a stoppage or lack of work.
- 15 (B) AN EMPLOYEE SHALL BE LAID OFF IF THE EMPLOYEE IS IN A SKILLED
- 16 SERVICE OR PROFESSIONAL SERVICE POSITION FOR WHICH THE FUNDING IS
- 17 ELIMINATED FROM THE BUDGET OR REDUCED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 7-213 OF THE
- 18 STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

- 20 (a) An employee is separated from State service when the appropriation in the
- 21 State budget for the position is:
- 22 (1) omitted by the Governor, as evidenced in the supporting
- 23 documentation submitted with the budget;
- 24 (2) struck by the General Assembly, as evidenced in the budget bill or in
- 25 the report of the budget committees; or
- 26 (3) reduced by the Governor in accordance with § 7-213 of the State
- 27 Finance and Procurement Article, as evidenced in the supporting documentation
- 28 submitted to the Board of Public Works.
- 29 (b) An employee may not appeal a separation from employment under this
- 30 section.
- 31 [(c) An employee who is separated under this section is not subject to the layoff
- 32 provisions of Subtitle 2 of this title with the exception that an employee who is
- 33 separated shall have the same reinstatement rights as a laid-off employee.]
- 34 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 35 effect October 1, 1998.
