3 FOR the purpose of providing that the police officers of the Natural Resources Police

- 4 Force are subject to the same salary plan as police officers of the Maryland
- 5 Department of State Police; providing that whenever police officers of the
- 6 Maryland Department of State Police receive a salary, grade, or step increase,
- 7 the police officers of the Natural Resources Police Force shall receive an equal
- 8 salary, grade, or step increase; and relating generally to the salaries of the police
- 9 officers of the Natural Resources Police Force.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

(A) THE POLICE OFFICERS OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES POLICE FORCE
SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE SAME SALARY PLAN, INCLUDING GRADES, STEPS, AND
INCREMENTS BASED ON LENGTH OF SERVICE, AS POLICE OFFICERS OF THE
MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE.
