## 2 Education - Public Schools - School Uniforms

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring each public elementary and secondary school in the
- 4 State to implement the use of school uniforms by all students in the public
- school if a certain percent of parents of students in the school approve of the
- 6 mandatory use of school uniforms, pursuant to a certain opinion survey; and
- 7 requiring each county board of education to assist the public schools in
- 8 implementing the mandatory use of school uniforms.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) (1) DURING THE 1998-1999 SCHOOL YEAR, THE RECOGNIZED
- 19 PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION AT EACH PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY
- 20 SCHOOL IN THE STATE SHALL CONDUCT AN OPINION SURVEY OF THE PARENTS OF
- 21 STUDENTS AT THE SCHOOL ON THE SUBJECT OF WHETHER TO IMPLEMENT THE
- 22 MANDATORY USE OF SCHOOL UNIFORMS IN THE SCHOOL.
- 23 (2) IF AT LEAST 51% OF THE RESPONDING PARENTS FAVOR MANDATORY
- 24 USE OF SCHOOL UNIFORMS. THE SCHOOL SHALL IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM OF
- 25 MANDATORY SCHOOL UNIFORMS BEGINNING IN THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR.
- 26 (B) THE COUNTY BOARD OF EACH COUNTY:
- 27 (1) SHALL FACILITATE THE OPINION SURVEYS REQUIRED UNDER THIS 28 SECTION: AND

- 1 (2) MAY SPECIFY THE TYPE OF CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR THAT A
- 2 SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY MAY REQUIRE IN IMPLEMENTING A MANDATORY SCHOOL
- 3 UNIFORM POLICY.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 July 1, 1998.
