



1 (3) Beer or wine delivered directly to a special beer and wine festival 2 licensee under paragraph (1) of this subsection may be returned directly to the 3 nonresident dealer. 4 (4)] (H) (1) PRODUCTS DISPLAYED AND SOLD SHALL BE: (I) INVOICED TO THE FESTIVAL LICENSE HOLDER BY A LICENSED 6 STATE WHOLESALER, WINERY, OR LIMITED WINERY; AND 7 DELIVERED TO THE FESTIVAL FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES 8 OF THE WHOLESALER, WINERY, OR LIMITED WINERY. 9 Whenever a festival license is issued pursuant to this subsection, (2) 10 holders of wholesale, WINERY, OR LIMITED WINERY licenses [or nonresident dealer 11 permits] may enter into an agreement with the holder of a festival license to deliver 12 beer and wine 2 days prior to the effective date, and to accept returns 2 days after the 13 expiration date of the festival license. 14 (i) The Board shall adopt regulations for implementing this section.
